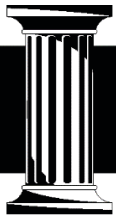

The Stations of the Cross, also known as "The Way of the Cross", are among the oldest and most venerable public devotions used during Lent. As early as the fourth century, Christian pilgrims walked in the footsteps of Jesus during His passion. The Stations took their current form in about the eighteenth century. At Holy Trinity, we celebrate the Stations each Friday during Lent at 6:00 PM. We ask that you and your family plan to join us as we pray and meditate while we remember Jesus' passion and death.

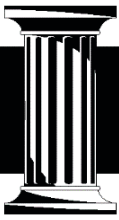

**WHEN:** We meet every other Tuesday morning after Mass (9:00-10:00) in the View Room for one hour.

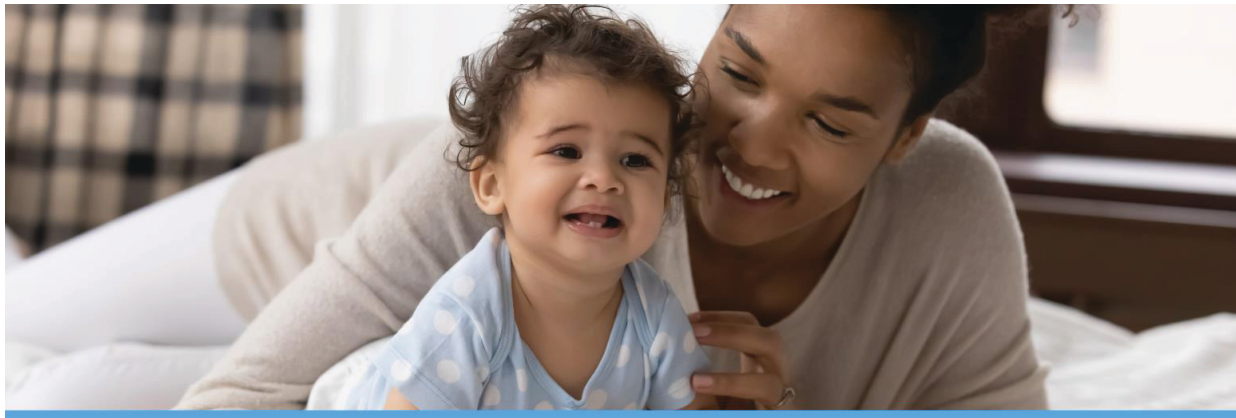

## ACCOMPLISHMENTS:

Because of your commitment to the *One Parish Family* Capital Campaign, Holy Trinity's financial position has improved dramatically:

- Pledged \$2.75 million - 90% - of our \$3.0 million goal to address parish debt and financial obligations and critical repairs and maintenance of our facilities.
- Paid \$1.2 million of those 3-year pledges, allowing us to
  - Repair the roofs on the Social and Education Centers
  - Pay-off the diocesan debt of \$413,000
  - Paid-down the debt on the Social and Education Centers by \$596,136– a 64 percent reduction!
- Positioned to begin critical repairs to the church bell tower and narthex in June.
