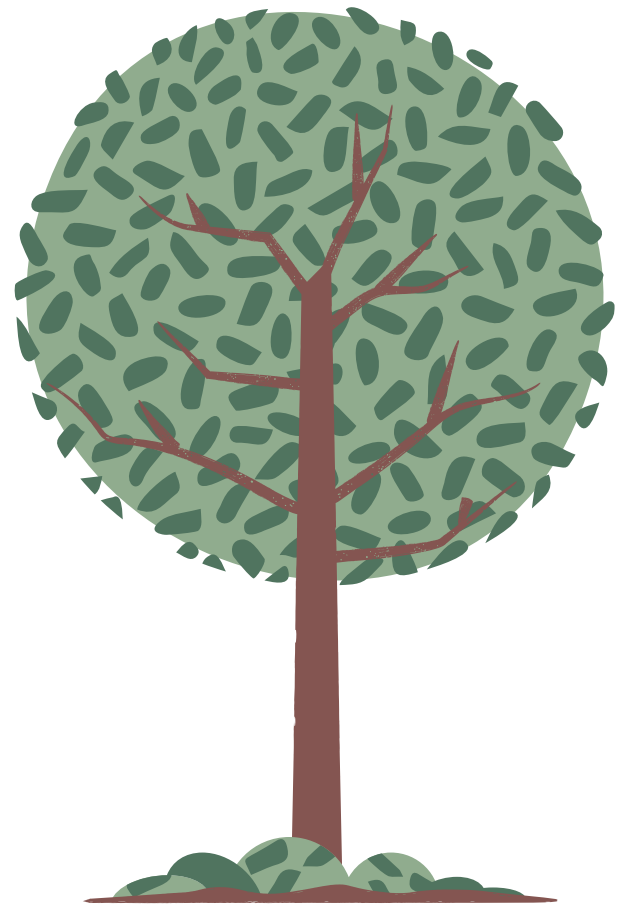
Spiritual Formation



Holy Trinity School Ministry is a Catholic Parish School and, as such, all students actively participate in the Religion programs. Faith development is presented through the study of Scripture, church doctrine, and tradition.

All students have religion classes daily. Class and school prayer services, and other liturgical celebrations are an integral part of the curriculum in our Catholic school.

Students are encouraged to practice Christian action and awareness of the needs of others by participating in a variety of service activities sponsored by the School.



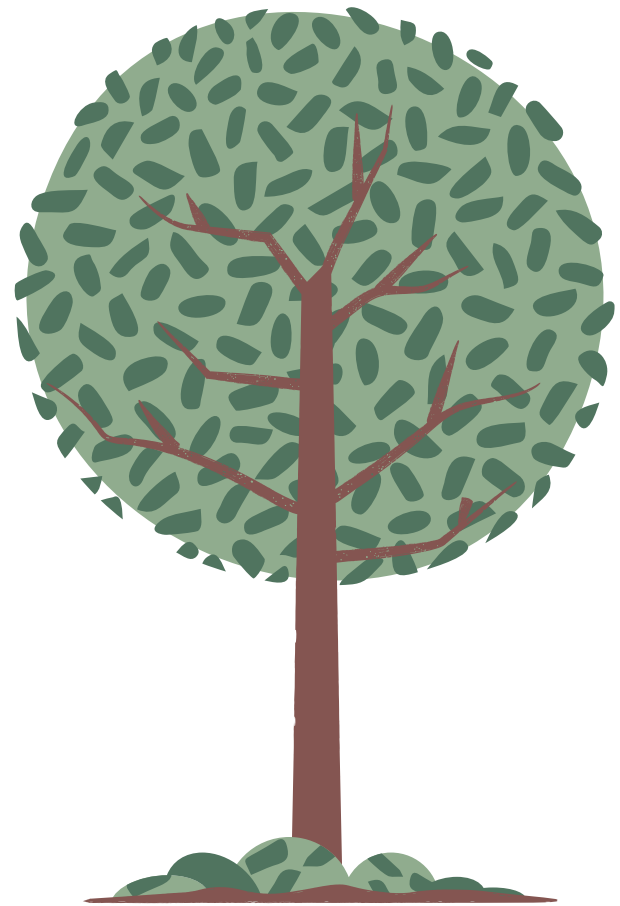
Prayer services and special Catholic observances will be offered at times throughout the school year. First Reconciliation, First Eucharist, and Confirmation are celebrated as a parish community, and registration for formation is through the Faith Formation Ministry. Each is a developmental formation that includes both classroom and parish preparation. The Holy Trinity School Ministry and Faith Formation Ministry together offer classroom study through the religion curriculum, parent meetings, practices, prayer services, and celebration of the sacrament.

STEM Programs & Academic Competitions

Holy Trinity's Robotics and Coding Programs offer students in first through eighth grades the opportunity to develop skills critical for the fields of SCIENCE, MATH, ENGINEERING, and TECHNOLOGY.

Students go through the engineering design process, develop critical thinking skills, problem-solve, collaborate, and communicate as they learn the basics of coding.

Other STEM programs such as the Science Olympiad, Nature Bowl, Mental Math Bowl, and Academic Decathlon provide students with additional opportunities to challenge themselves and grow in the areas of math and science.



Extracurricular Activities

Extra-curricular activities allow students to develop leadership skills, pursue individual interests, and just have fun!

Student government, academic teams, athletics, and clubs provide numerous opportunities for students to enhance their learning beyond the classroom. Students are also encouraged to offer their leadership to Masses, both during the week and on Sundays. Through enrichment activities, students learn valuable skills to serve their fellow students, the parish, and the broader community.

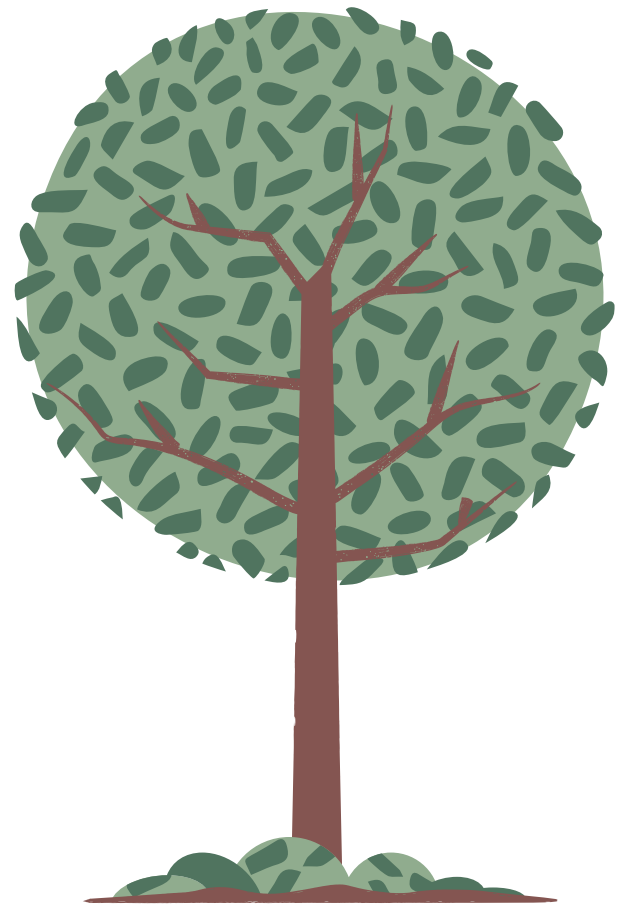
In a non-Covid Year Activities may Include: Student Tribunal Academic Decathlon, Nature Bowl, Math Decathlon, Religion Decathlon, Chess Club, Robotics Club, Spelling Bee Competitions, Diocesan Speech Contest, Choir, Band, Violin, Guitar, Choral Festivals, Lectors Club, Ignite Youth Group for middle school children, 6th and 8th Grade week-long Science Camps, and numerous field trips in each grade.

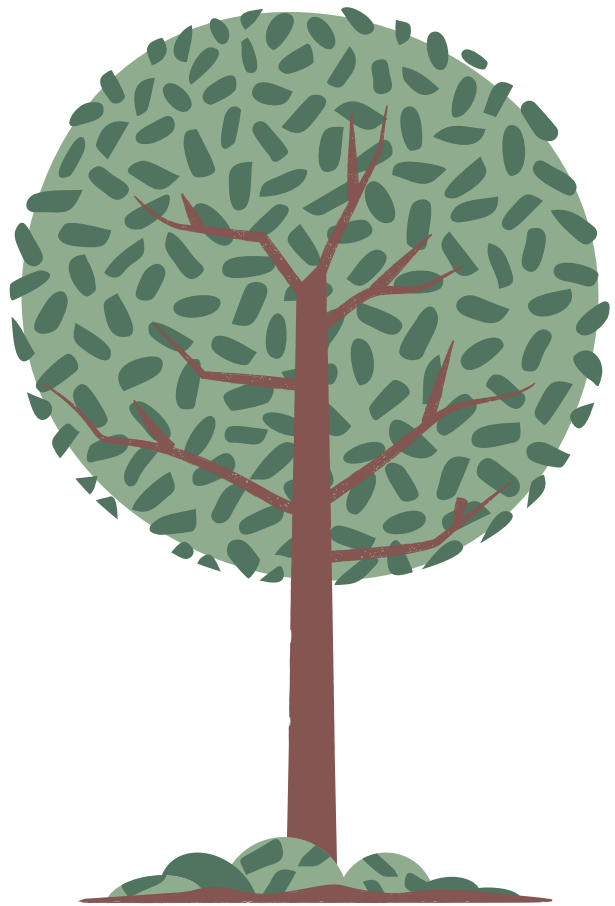

Extended Day Program (EDP)

The Extended Day Program (EDP) is an extension of the school day, both before and after school. Only students of Holy Trinity School may be enrolled. The program is staffed by school personnel and is open each day that school is in session, regardless of the length of the school day. EDP offers snacks, access to computers for our students to work on homework, activities, and provides an opportunity for outside play.
